



Boulder Valley Conservation District  
Scholarship Award

***Application Due April 1, 2024***

The Boulder Valley Conservation District is pleased to offer one \$500 scholarship to a high school senior graduating from a school within the boundaries of the Conservation District. The student must be pursuing further education at a college, junior college, university, or trade school in an agriculture-related or a natural resources field. Examples of related fields include but are not limited to: ag business, agronomy, ag related journalism, veterinary or animal science, ag engineering or natural resources.

Applications will be accepted from students already enrolled in a college or program but will be considered only after any high school student applicants. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the educational institution.

The Board of Supervisors of the Boulder Valley Conservation District will choose the scholarship winner at their April Business Meeting. The scholarship winner will be selected based on a written essay, leadership, high school activities, academic record, character, and sincerity.

**ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

1. Applicant must have a home address within the Boulder Valley Conservation District boundaries. The District is south of Highway 52, north of 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue and west of I-25.
2. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application. One letter must be from a school faculty member who has taught the applicant as a student.
3. Include a current transcript with the application.
4. A 250 - 500 word essay on soil and water conservation must accompany the application.
5. Postmark the application no later than April 1, 2024.
6. The scholarship winner will be announced after the April Board meeting.
7. The recipient must notify the Boulder Valley Conservation District office of acceptance or refusal of the scholarship, in writing, within 30 days or the scholarship will be passed on to an alternate.
